**MBBS: in the field of Clinical Research**


**REPORT**


Clinical trials are essential for the development of new treatments. Every new medicine and treatment started with volunteers participating in clinical trials. US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) of USA maintains & guides all the protocols and step by step procedures of clinical trials. In addition to testing new drugs and devices, clinical trials provide a scientific basis for advising and treating patients. Even when researchers do not obtain the outcomes they predicted, trial results can help point doctors & scientists in the correct direction.

Physicians play a key role in successful completion of clinical trials. Being well-prepared to answer of common questions of patients and family members to take decision about participation in trials and being as principal investigator a doctor is responsible to conduct all phases of clinical trials.




Clinical trials are conducted in a series of steps called “phases.” Each phase has a different purpose and helps researchers answer different questions.

- **Phase I trials:** Researchers & Doctors test a drug or treatment in a small group of people (20–80) for the first time. The purpose is to study the drug or treatment to learn about safety and identify side effects.
- **Phase II trials:** The new drug or treatment is given to a larger group of people (100–300) to determine its effectiveness and to further study its safety.
- **Phase III trials:** The new drug or treatment is given to large groups of people (1,000–3,000) to confirm its effectiveness, monitor side effects, compare it with standard or similar treatments, and collect information that will allow the new drug or treatment to be used safely.
- **Phase IV trials:** After a drug is approved by the FDA and made available to the public, researchers track its safety in the general population, seeking more information about a drug or treatment’s benefits, and optimal use.

- Careers in Clinical Research – M. Sc.(Clinical Research), PGDCR (PG diploma in Clinical Research), PGDPV (PG diploma in Pharmacovigilance), PGDCDM (PG diploma in clinical data management)

- Students interested in Clinical Research were given details of different establishments (government/ private/ corporate) and told about requirement of such establishment.



With a steep rise in dental issues due to several reasons and a lack of a sufficient number of expert doctors, BDS is one of the most sought-after degree courses. BDS programme offers abundant career opportunities to students who can work in hospitals, pharmaceutical companies, and the medical device manufacturing industries. After attaining the degree from a well-recognized college or university, candidates can start their own practice as a dentist who diagnoses dental problems and suggest treatment plans accordingly. There is a great future in academics, research, and government departments as well for the BDS students. Index Institute of Dental Sciences, Indore organised a career counselling session to enable students to know more about career prospects, scope, and job profiles for BDS graduates.

Dr. Swathi Sudhapalli addressed the participants and first took their opinion about their future endeavours. Students shared their insecurities about their future and were distressed about the negative publicity done by few regarding dentistry.

Dr. Swathi encouraged the students and explained that earlier, there used to be limited scope for BDS students who had to either go for higher education or start their own private practice. Today there are numerous options to these graduates. They can choose to work among the following employment areas:

Pharmaceutical Companies

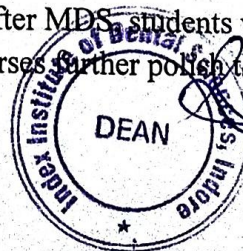

Masters in Dental Surgery (MDS): After BDS, candidates can do a master's course. The admission is provided on the basis of the scores in NEET MDS exam conducted by NBE. Those who clear the entrance exam get admission to different MDS specialisation courses. After MDS students who aim for higher study can opt for fellowship and Ph.D courses. These courses further polish their skill and enhance their knowledge in different aspects of dental surgery.

Another promising avenue discussed was Masters in Public Health (MPH). This is another course which students can opt to spur career growth. Those who don't want to choose a traditional field can go for this course which makes them learn the skill to manage public health. After the course, these candidates are recruited in various roles of administration or management, policy, community practice, and research. Dr. Swathi emphasized the need for giving due consideration to public health dentistry as there is good scope for growth and students can work to make a real difference.

Masters in Business Administration is another professional course that provides alternative career options to students. Students learn the professional skills of management and administration which helps them to get recruited by medical institutes, hospitals, nursing homes, and NGOs operating in the health sector.

Research and Advisory Departments are great avenues for those who have interest towards research. You can apply for the 'Dental Research Assistant' and 'Dental Research Coordinator' posts in the Research Department Recruitments. It offers high perks and excellent promotional avenues.

Students also enquired about UPSC Exam with a chance to Join Civil Services (IAS, IPS, IFS, IRS). Dr. Swathi mentioned that UPSC offers a wide range of job opportunities for the BDS Graduates. You must not overlook these options since this job offers lucrative perks and high prestige and power to bring about reforms in the society you reside in.

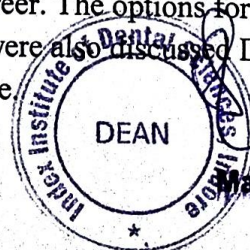
Also there are job opportunities in industries manufacturing oral care products you can also apply for job openings in Industries under the Government Sector which are involved in research & development including devices and medicines.

Next option discussed was forensic odontology. Forensic science is a vital instrument for the detection or investigation of crime and the administration of justice, providing crucial information about the evidence found at the crime scene. The training and education of forensic scientists provide a solid scientific background and a broad base in criminalistics and is an exciting a venue to explore.

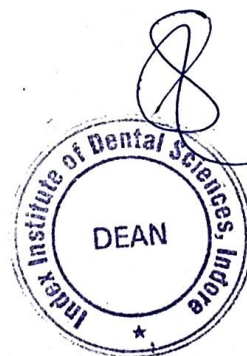
