Overview

Index nursing college affiliated to Malwanchal University organized training programme for non teaching staff on "CPR USE OF CRASH CART OTHER LIFE SUPPORT MEASURES" from 09th to 13th August 2021 under the guidance of Dr. Prof. Smriti G Solomon, Principal, Index Nursing College and with the blessings of Shri. Course outline:

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) is a lifesaving technique that's useful in many emergencies, such as a heart attack or near drowning, in which someone's breathing or heartbeat has stopped.

Crash cart is set in hospital for transporting and dispensing emergency medicine/equipments at site of medical/surgical emergency .for life support protocol (ACLS/ALS) to potentially saves some one's life.

The program was organized for three days and the timings were from 1:00 am to 4:00pm. The first day session was started with registration at 2:00am. This was followed by inaugural ceremony. The Chief Guest was Dr. Saurabh Jain , Indore, M.P.. The inauguration session was started with lighting the lamp by the chief guest with the Principal and Organizing Secretary. The afternoon session was headed by Mr. Jitendra



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Chicholkar, Assistant Professor, Index Nursing College on "USES OF EMERGENCY DRUGS".

Safe anaesthetics practice Workshop


A work shop was conducted on Safe anaesthetics practice on 13th Oct 2019 at Index Medical College, Hospital and Research Centre, Malwanchal University from 10 am to 1 pm. A total 13 technical staff participated in the programme.


The speakers for the workshop were as follows:

- Risk and management —Dr. A. M. Nayyar Associate Prof, Department of Physiology
- Legal aspect – Dr. Rahul Tanwani Prof, Department of Surgery

The speaker explained the importance of safe anaesthetic practices and its benefits. They suggested that every patient should undergo a doctor anaesthetist-led preoperative evaluation, and every effort should be made to optimize the condition of the patient in the available time. It was also emphasized that there should be checklist to record the following:

- The condition of the patient.
- The patient has received relevant information on the anaesthetic procedure, including risk.
- General standards for Anaesthesia


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1. Professional Status

The provision of anaesthesia is a vital component of basic health care and merits an appropriate share of the available resources. It is highly recommended that anaesthetists should be appropriately trained and accredited medical specialists with clinical and administrative autonomy.

2. Professional Organization

Anaesthetists should form appropriate organizations at local, regional, and national levels for the setting of standards of practice, supervision of training and continuing education with appropriate certification and accreditation, and general promotion of anaesthesia as an independent professional specialty..


3. Training, Certification and Accreditation

Adequate time and facilities should be available for professional training, both initial and continuing, to ensure that an adequate standard of knowledge, expertise, and practice is attained and maintained.

4. Records and Statistics

A record of the details and course of each anaesthetic should be made and preserved with the patient's medical record. This should include details of the pre-operative assessment and the post-operative course.

5. Workload


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A sufficient number of trained anaesthetists should be available so that individuals may practice to a high standard. Time should be allocated for professional development, administration, research, and teaching.

6. Personnel

An anaesthetist must be dedicated to each patient and be present throughout each anaesthetic (general, regional, or monitored sedation), and should be responsible for the, transport of the patient to the post-anaesthesia recovery facility and the transfer of care to appropriately trained personnel.


7. Facilities and Equipment


Appropriate equipment and facilities, adequate both in quantity and quality, should be present wherever anaesthesia and its recovery is undertaken.

Legal aspects and importance of proper documentation was also discussed ,and the role of supporting staff was brought forth.

Some of the key points include:

- Information to patients and consent.
- Documentation of all anaesthetics.
- Documentation of unexpected events.
- Following up unexpected incidents/problems/deaths.


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- Shortcomings with equipment, staffing, etc., which are an obstacle to providing safe anaesthetics, should be reported to the relevant authorities.


At the end of the workshop few cases were discussed, few methodologies were analysed and this was followed by a Q/A session.

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Safe Paediatric Care Workshop

A Safe Paediatric Care Workshop Program was organized on 6th Oct 2018 for the non-teaching staff at Index Medical College, Hospital and Research Centre, Malwanchal University from 10 am to 1 pm. A total 15 technical staff participated in the programme.


The speakers for the workshop were as follows:


- Objectives paediatric safety — Dr. Swathi prashant, prof, department of Paediatrics
- Paediatric intensive care measures – Dr. Naikey minarey, assoc. prof, department of paediatrics

The workshop targeted pediatricians in the secondary health institutions and nurses working at the pediatric critical care (PICU) and premature babies care units across the Sultanate.

The two-day workshop aimed at upgrading competency of health institutions and health workers in the field of safe transfer of pediatric patients, in addition to qualifying an advanced CPR-trained team.

The workshop included both lectures and on-hand training on children resuscitation, and first and advanced aids.


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
It was started with a discussion regarding general findings about safety and quality; This followed by a discussion on the initiatives taken up by the institution as a whole; then a guide was explained on how to maintain quality care and evidence-based practice for specific areas of paediatric care; and recommendations about how we can move paediatric safety and quality forward in practice and in the policy arena.

The experts discussed a variety of expertise and care models, for consideration as standard measures for generalized use.


Standards


- A consultant paediatrician should be present and readily available in the hospital during times of peak activity, seven days a week.
- Every child who is admitted to a paediatric department with an acute medical problem is seen by a healthcare professional with the appropriate competencies to work on the tier two (middle grade) paediatric rota within four hours of admission.
- Every child who is admitted to a paediatric department with an acute medical problem is seen by a consultant paediatrician* within 14 hours of admission, with more immediate review as required according to illness severity or if a member staff is concerned.


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- At least two medical handovers every 24 hours are led by a consultant paediatrician.
- Every child with an acute medical problem who is referred for a paediatric opinion is seen by, or has their case discussed with, a clinician with the necessary skills and competencies before they are discharged. This could be: a paediatrician on the consultant rota, a paediatrician on the tier two (middle grade) rota, or a registered children's nurse who has completed a recognised advanced children's nurse practitioner programme and is an advanced children's nurse practitioner.
- Throughout all the hours they are open, paediatric assessment units have access to the opinion of a consultant paediatrician .
- All general paediatric inpatient units adopt an attending consultant system, most often in the form of the 'consultant of the week' system.
- All general paediatric training rotas are made up of at least ten whole time equivalent posts, all of which are compliant with the UK Working Time Regulations and European Working Time Directive.
- Specialist paediatricians are available for immediate telephone advice for acute problems for all specialties, and for all paediatricians.


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The key issues in this matter were discussed regarding paediatric care and maintain standards in the hospital. The role of the supporting staff was brought forth, their role was explained and appreciated. Similarly, Paediatric intensive care was also spoken about and the major issues that the staff deals with was brought forth.

At the end of the discussion, the participants were asked to give a feedback and write their suggestions.
